We will arrange to acquire the item(s) and get them to you. Currently the plan is to make **shopping runs on Mondays and Thursday**, this of course, is subject to change depending on demand. For those who have contracted the virus or suspect they have we will find a way to get essentials to you so that you don't feel pressured to go into the community - thus adding to the spread of the virus.

Please restrict to essential items, we are not a shopping service, but we are concerned about helping any high risk community members reduce their vulnerability to this virus.

They are expectedly busy right now so delivery times are delayed to the following day and many items are out of stock in the stores, but shoppers will deliver items to your doorstep (or gate) and all payment/interactions can happen online or over text.
